



Northside Baptist Church Care Center

The Northside Care Center exists to provide for the immediate food and clothing to families in our community that live in poverty. The Care Center also exists to find long-term solutions to the challenges that clients face. Approximately 25 volunteers work on a weekly basis to provide for the food and clothing needs of our clients. Kimberly Stutts, the Minister of Benevolence and Missions, also provides other services to clients including limited counseling, budgeting skills, and referrals to other social service agencies.

There are a number of ways for Northside members to get involved at the Care Center:

Give Your Time

We are open Monday, Wednesday, and Fridays from 9am-12pm and 1pm-4pm. Volunteer opportunities include working in the Food Pantry, Clothing Department, and the reception area. There are also opportunities to help on Thursday mornings when the North Texas Food Bank delivers to Navarro County as well as one-time projects on Saturdays.

Give Food/Supplies

The Care Center has a working relationship with the North Texas Food Bank in Dallas, Texas. Because of this relationship, we are able to pay a shared maintenance fee of 14-18 cents a pound for food. While we receive most of our food from the North Texas Food Bank, but are often items that we are not able to get from the Food Bank. Watch the Sunday Bulletin for specific items that the Care Center is in need of each week.

Give Money

The Care Center operates strictly off of donations from church and community members. \$1=4 meals.
