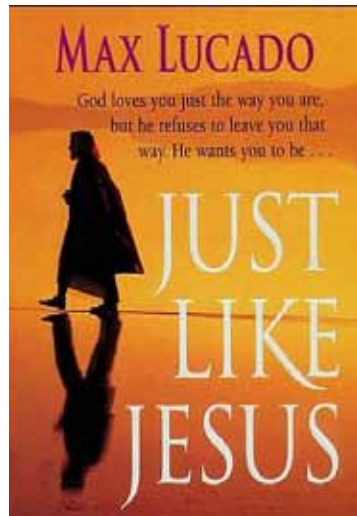

Over the last 10 months, I have asked you to support our Care Center by bringing a certain kind of food item each month. **We collected 650 boxes of Mac and Cheese, 1,831 cans of soup, and 1,300 cans of fruit, just to name a few.** While the Care Center still needs your support through donations of food and clothes, we will not have a specific food emphasis this month. Instead,

we will be joining forces with others in our community to collect school supplies. Do you remember how important it was to walk into school on that first day of school, supplies in hand, ready to tackle a new school year? **It is difficult for families living in poverty to be able to buy school supplies for their children each year.** Some grades require almost \$75 worth of school supplies---can you imagine that multiplied by 2 or 3 children? Our church will be participating in this community wide effort by collecting writing school supplies (i.e. pencils, pens, markers, highlighters, and crayons) so we can help kids start the new school year on the "write" foot! **Please bring your school supplies by August 15th.** They will then be taken to Westminster Presbyterian Church where they will be given out by the Child and Family Program beginning on August 17th. **I hope that you will join us and help kids in our community start the school year on the "write" foot!**

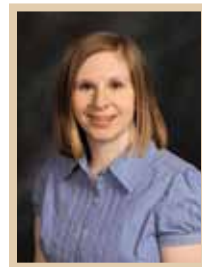
